Qualifications

Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age or older. Applicants must successfully complete a minimal background investigation. New members are required to attend all phases of our STARS Academy.

Selection Process

- ▶ Meet all minimum qualifications
- ▶ Pass an oral interview
- ▶ Pass a background investigation
- ▶ Final approval by the sheriff
