What is a STARS Volunteer?

The STARS Volunteer Organization consist of a group of citizen volunteers committed to public service. Created in 1996, the Yuba County Sheriff Department's STARS Volunteer Organization provides support to the Sheriff's Department and the citizens of Yuba County. Each year our STARS volunteers contribute thousands of hours in a variety of capacities.

Qualifications

Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age. Applicants must successfully complete a minimal background investigation. New members are required to attend all phases of our STARS Academy.

Selection Process

- ▶ Meet all minimum qualifications
- ▶ Pass an oral interview
- ▶ Pass a background investigation
- ▶ Final approval by the sheriff



HOW TO APPLY

Applications are accepted on a continuous basis. You can obtain an application at the Sheriff's Department's Main Office located at 720 Yuba Street, Marysville, CA.
